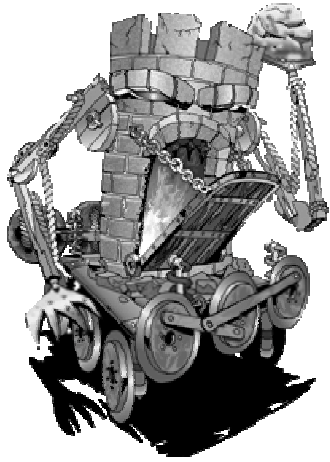




## ACADEMIC CHESS SATURDAY TOURNAMENTS
